In recent years, Ecohomes has been involved in many projects for both large national and international companies such as the Tanzanian banks CRDB, Stanbic Bank, and the French company TOTAL, as well as participated in government projects. Ecohomes has also been involved in a large construction project known as "Star Home", consisting of 110 homes in the the Mtwara region. The project was recently featured on BBC.
